S5+Baccalaureate program S6+S7

- S5 is an orientation year many mandatory subjects and few electives.
- S6 and S7 are the baccalaureate years few mandatory subjects and many electives.
- Mandatory subjects include L1, L2, Math, Physical Education, Religious Studies, Philosophy, History and Geography.
- History and Geography are taught in L2.
- Elective subjects can be taught in English
