What is the mobility program?



- Mobility = school exchange in S5
- 2 programmes in ESCPH
 - ⇒ Exchange between European Schools for 4 months
 - ⇒ Exchange with France (Académie de Lyon)

**It's a family
project !**

Mobility programme between European schools

- Exchange programme

⇒ Students can go study in another European school – Official or accredited

⇒ First semester of S5 : September - December



⇒ Students study in a European School abroad while staying with a host family. In return, their family are hosting the student from the other European School

Example

Ava is going to Bruxelles where she'll stay with **Marie's family**

Marie is coming to Copenhagen and stay with **Ava's family**

What are the aims of this program for students?



- To improve academic and language skills

⇒ Students should speak their L2/L3 language with their host families

⇒ Students should follow classes in their L1 language section. But there may be exceptions (SWALS students).

Example

- **Amanda** is in S5DA class and she's going to Frankfurt
- She's staying in a German family
- In Frankfurt, there's Danish L1 BUT no Danish section
- She has Danish L1 BUT all the subjects are taught in English

What are the aims of this program for students?



- **To improve academic and language skills**

- ⇒ **Students should speak their L2/L3 language with their host families**

- ⇒ **Students should follow classes in their L1 language section. But there may be exceptions (SWALS students).**

- **To experience different cultural and educational environments**

- ⇒ **Culture is not easily learned in a classroom. We need to experience the country. By living in another country, students also become more mature and open-minded!**

Where to go ?

- European schools - both official and accredited
- You can choose a maximum of three schools in order of preference
- Only 2 schools have a Danish section : Brussels I and Luxembourg II

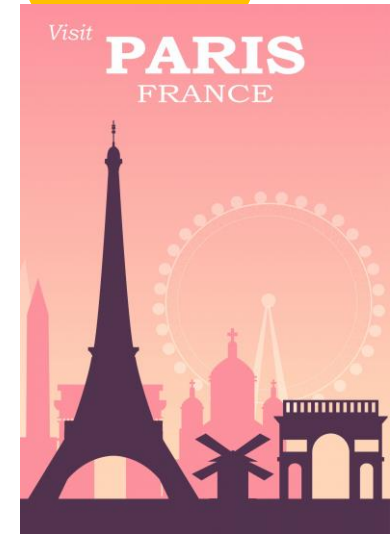
Before you apply, please read all the table and **find a school with your language section and options**

Exception can be made :

- Danish section could ask to follow class in L1EN if they are able to follow an other L2 than English
- Remember that History and Geography are taught in L2 !
- Class council will decide if you can go and change your L2 temporarily or not

Exchange programme with France

- Hosting programme
 - October : you host a student for 4 weeks – including autumn break
 - March : you go to France for 4 weeks – including Easter break



Example :

In October **Marie** is coming to Copenhagen and stay with **Ava and her family**

In March **Ava** is going to Lyon and stay with **Marie and her family**



Exchange programme with France

- **You don't need to speak French**
 - French high school for 2 weeks in an international section
 - Some classes are taught in English e.g. History
 - **Mandatory request:** to have a bedroom available for the student you'll host
 - You won't come back with grades
-

Important remark

- It is the responsibility of the student to catch up if the program in the schools involved is not alike.
- If there are subjects that are not covered at the hosting school, the results of the 2nd semester at the home school count double



Cost for families

- School fees for the exchange period are paid to the home school.
- The host school and family should not charge for the stay.
- Families can be invoiced for additional expenses such as school trips.

Procedure

- Application
 - ⇒ **Monday 23rd October until Friday 10th November**
 - ⇒ Online form : [click here](#)
 - ⇒ Both programmes
- Late applications will not be examined



Procedure

- ESCPH evaluates the application **in November**
 - Class council approve (or not)
 - Criteria : grades and behavior – Ability to catch up the classes missed
- Student will receive the class council's decision at the end of November



Procedure

- ESPCH from **January to March**
 - Send our student's application to European schools / France
 - Receive application from other European schools / France
 - Try to solve the puzzle
- If the application has been accepted, student will receive an acceptance letter **in May / June**



Important remarks

⇒ ESCPH organises the application process between European schools

⇒ ESCPH doesn't organise transportation, insurance, and research for host family
